17. Health Information:

The Official Veterinarian certifies that:

- a) The products were produced in an establishment officially registered with the Inspection Department of Animal Products – DIPOA, subjected to regular official inspections.
- b) The products have been obtained from bones of animals slaughtered in a abattoir approved by Brazilian competent authority.
- c) The products have been sourced from bones of animals which have passed official anti-mortem and post mortem examination during slaughtering.
- d) ⁽¹⁾The products have been sourced from country which has been categorized under negligible risk for Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy (BSE) by World Organization for Animal Health (OIE);
or
⁽²⁾The country is posing a controlled BSE risk and bones are derived from bovine animals that are over 30 months of age at the time of slaughter; passed ante- and post-mortem inspections; skulls and vertebral column have been excluded and do not contain specific risk materials as defined in the Terrestrial Animal Health Code of World Organization of Animal Health have been removed;
- e) ⁽¹⁾The products sourced animals come from establishments that are not placed under movement restrictions for the control of anthrax;
or
⁽²⁾The bones have been subjected to:
i. ⁽¹⁾a process which includes all of the following steps: degreasing, acid demineralisation, acid or alkaline treatment, filtration, sterilization at >138°C for a minimum of 4 seconds, or
ii. ⁽¹⁾an equivalent or better process in terms of infectivity reduction (such as high pressure heating).
or
⁽²⁾The raw material has been reduced to a maximum particle size of 50 mm before heating; and the raw material was subjected to moist heat at one of the following temperature and time regimes:
i. ⁽¹⁾105°C for at least 8 minutes; or
ii. ⁽¹⁾100°C for at least 10 minutes; or
iii. ⁽¹⁾95°C for at least 25 minutes; or
iv. ⁽¹⁾90°C for at least 45 minutes;
or
⁽²⁾The raw material has been subjected to dry heat at one of the following temperature and time regimes:
i. ⁽¹⁾130°C for at least 20 minutes; or
ii. ⁽¹⁾125°C for at least 25 minutes; or
iii. ⁽¹⁾120°C for at least 45 minutes;
iv. ⁽¹⁾an industrial process demonstrated to be of equivalent efficacy (to be approved in advance by Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying - DAHD of India).
- f) The products were packed into unused and cleaned bags or the crushed and gel bones are loaded in a bulk in the container in loose condition.
- g) The consignment(s) destined to India do not contain beef and beef products in any form.
